RV Site Guidelines

Under Caravan Park and Camping Ground Regulations 1997, Council can provide an unfettered Rest Area for up to 72 hours, on land vested or owned by Council; beyond that period permission is required in writing from the WA Minister for Local Government.

A Rest Area is NOT a licenced camp area as defined by Regulation 49 of the Act.

Specifics:

The Campervan and Motorhome Club of Australia (CMCA) does not promote unrestricted access to a Rest Area that has been set up by Council as part of the RV Friendly Town Scheme.

CMCA requests Council Rest Areas conform to the Leave No Trace Code of Practice.

1. Vehicles using the Rest Area must be fully self-contained defined either by certification by CMCA, as conforming to the CMCA Leave No Trace (LNT) Scheme, or inspection by a Council Officer.
2. The rest area is NOT available to those in tents or non-conforming vehicles.
3. All waste **MUST** be contained within the vehicle, with nothing released to ground.
4. There is no dump point within the Rest Area. Council signage indicates their locations at:
 - 4.1. Gwalia town site, adjacent to the public toilets
 - 4.2. Leonora Information Bay, Tower Street, Leonora.
5. Mobile power generators external to the vehicle should only be used to top-up Internal batteries. Maximum 2 hours any time up to 6pm and not before 7am.
6. Use of the short-term rest area is restricted to no more than 72 HOURS.
7. Vehicle chocks impacting in a negative way on the parking surface are not permitted. More noticeable on wet or damp ground.
8. Non-self-contained vehicles should use the caravan park located on Rochester Street, Leonora.
9. Externally strung washing lines breach the LNT scheme and are a safety hazard
10. Shire Rangers/Officers are authorised to issue immediate move-on directions for noncompliance. Your cooperation is appreciated.
11. All vehicles are to be parked as directed by Shire Officers so as not to obstruct reasonable passage, exit or access to other vehicles or property.
12. Open fires, including fire pits are not permitted.
